

Strategix International College offers a wide range of study options for international students from basic English through to Diploma level courses.

Strategix English Language Programs

Successful completion of 12 weeks of Strategix's IELTS Preparation Program will give students direct entry into any Strategix International College Certificate or Diploma course.




Strategix Business Programs

BSB50215 Diploma of Business (095791M)

The Diploma of Business can assist students get ahead in a variety of fields including marketing, human resources, and finance. This course will provide students with the skills and knowledge to start their own business, or explore roles in business administration, management, marketing, project work and more.

Students will learn the fundamentals of effective business practice including people management, business finance, marketing, project and risk management along with handling the recruitment and selection process.

The Diploma of Business course is suited to individuals who have the passion to increase their career opportunities in business, including small business owners, entrepreneurs and new entrants to the corporate business career pathway.



BSB51915 Diploma of Leadership and Management (095790A)

The Diploma of Leadership and Management is designed to provide students with practical skills, knowledge and understanding required to manage all aspects of a business.

Managers and supervisors have significant and important roles within an organisation including team development, recruiting staff, managing performance issues, leadership and managing safety and risk. This course will provide students with the tools and strategies to manage themselves, others and the organisation.

CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (097311E)

The Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care helps prepare and develop students skills for a range of early childhood educational settings. The course is developed within the Education and Care Services National regulations and the National Quality Standard.

The course will help prepare students for a range of childcare and related administrative roles. Students will cover subjects from cultural competence, providing care, ethical and legal practices, nutrition, first aid, workplace health and safety, holistic development strategies and utilising approved early learning frameworks. CHC50113 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care (097313C)

CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (097310F)
